

## Directions for the Block Ranking System

The purpose of the blocks is so the judge can rank the performances of the competitors as the event goes on. The goal is to have everyone in their ranking order at the end of the last contestant's performance.

On this example the first one to perform was Suzy. This automatically made her in the first place position with her 55 points.

Next, was Tom. He earned 57 so he became first and Suzy was moved to second.

3rd was Joe-he did poorly with a 30. Tom and Suzy remain where they are and Joe becomes 3rd.

4th was Pat. He got a 51, so he was put in 3rd place after Suzy but before Joe.

5th came Jill, she performed and tied with Suzy in points but the judge thought Suzy was more personable and Jill was hard to hear so Suzy stays in second with a memo and Jill becomes 3rd with her note of performance.

The grid just keeps going until all have performed.
