(1) An official determination was made by the Office of Administration that this position code is social security exempt, see <http://oa.mo.gov/acct/faqsub.htm>.

(2) While this position is social security covered, if an individual is certificated as a VI teacher, the Direct Service/Instruction Visually Impaired code (195100) could be used instead of the Ancillary O&M code for delivery of those services. VI teachers can appropriately provide O&M services as part of their instructional activities.

(3) While this position is social security covered, if an individual is DESE certificated, other codes might be just as appropriate, such as the Ancillary Vocational Adjustment/Work Experience Coordinator code, for that service delivery. Instructional codes such as Community Based Instruction (195700) and Work Experience Instruction (195800) could be considered and Guidance Personnel/Placement Specialist codes such as Vocational Placement Coordinator (885020) and Career Education Resource Educator (995030) could be considered dependent on the services provided.
